

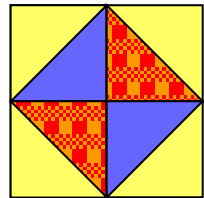
Sewing Machine Cover

Make this pretty patchwork cover to protect your sewing machine whilst in your sewing room. This size has been made to fit a Husqvarna Viking Sapphire machine as well as the Designer Diamond and the Topaz. It will also fit the other brands with an extended sewing surface and cover most sewing machines and protect them from dust.

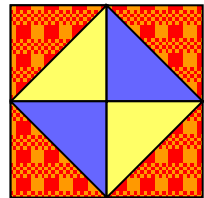
Blocks 1 & 2

Select the following fabrics:

	Side 1	Side 2
Fabric A:	yellow	pale gold
Fabric B:	orange check	pink check
Fabric C:	Sapphire Agate	dark maroon



Block 1

Preparation

1. Cut all 6 fabrics into strips $2\frac{7}{8}$ " wide
2. Cut fabrics A & B into 9 squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ "
3. Cut fabrics C into 6 squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ "

Method (make two sets, one for each side)

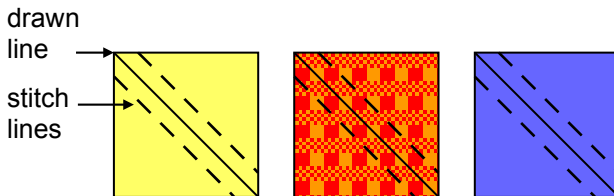

1. Draw a diagonal on the reverse side of squares from Fabric A, **Figure 1**.
2. Place right sides together with 6 Fabric B check squares and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " either side of the drawn line.

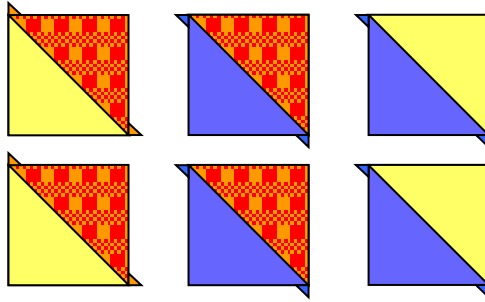

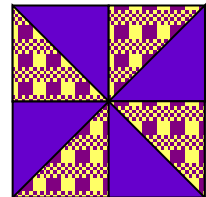
3. Cut across the centre diagonal line to produce twelve half square triangles, **Figure 2**.
4. Draw a diagonal on the reverse side of squares from Fabric C.
5. Place right sides together with 3 Fabric B check squares and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " either side of the drawn line.
6. Cut across the centre diagonal line to produce six half square triangles.
7. Place right sides together with 3 Fabric A squares and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " either side of the drawn line.
8. Cut across the centre diagonal line to produce six half square triangles.
9. Trim to a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
10. Sew these squares together to make 3 of Block 1 and 3 of Block 2.

Pinwheel Blocks

Select the following fabrics:

Fabric A: check yellow/mauve

Fabric B: Sapphire Garnet



Pinwheel
Block

Preparation

1. Cut fabrics A & B into strips $2\frac{7}{8}$ " wide.
2. Cut each fabric into 22 squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ ".

Method

1. Draw a line across the centre diagonal of the reverse of each dark square, **Figure 3**.

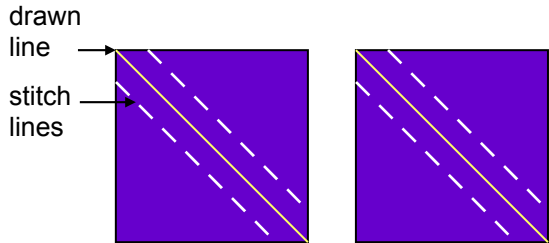
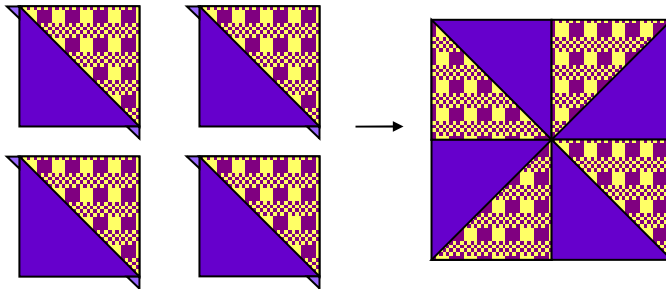

2. Place right sides together with a check square and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " either side of the drawn line as shown.
3. Cut across the centre diagonal line to produce two Half Square Triangles.

4. Place 4 of these units together to make the Pinwheel block, **Figure 4**.
5. Trim to a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
6. Make 11 blocks.

Assembling Front and Back Panels

Using Sapphire Purple Diamond for the yellow/orange check/Sapphire Agate side and Sapphire Sunstone for the pale gold/pink check/dark maroon side cut for each front and back:

- 2 strips $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 1 strip 2" x $20\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 4 side strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3"
- 4 sashing strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2"

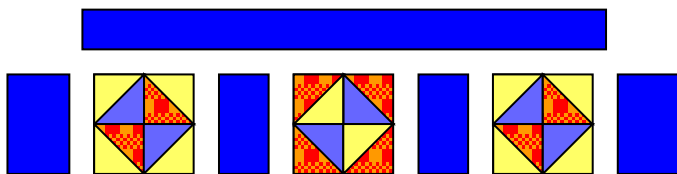
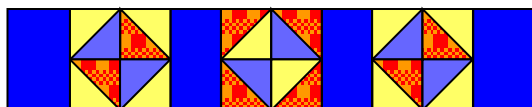

1. Arrange 3 each of Blocks 1 and 2 as shown, **Figure 5**.

2. Sew sashing strips between blocks and side strips at the ends, **Figure 6**.
3. Sew wide strip between the blocks to join them
4. Sew narrow strips to the top and bottom, **Figure 7**.
5. Repeat for back panel

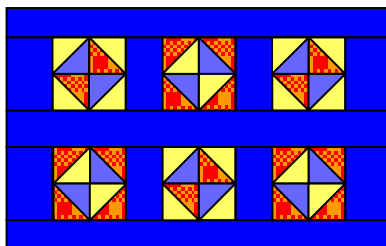

Making the Cover

Assembling the Top

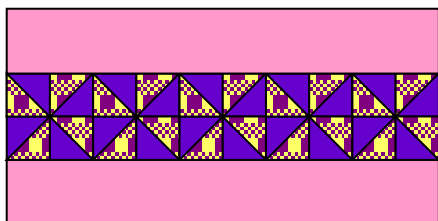

1. From pink fabric cut 2 strips $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 20\frac{1}{2}''$.
2. Join 5 Pinwheel blocks together and attach a strip to either side, **Figure 8**.

Assembling the Side Panels (make 2)

1. From pink fabric cut 2 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
2. Join 3 Pinwheel blocks together and attach a strip to either side, **Figure 9**.

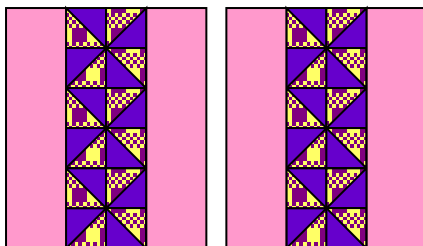

Quilting

1. From wadding (batting) cut:
 - Front and back - 23 " x 15 "
 - Top - 12 " x 23 "
 - 2 x Side panels - 12 " x 15 "
2. Pin the patchwork on top of the wadding leaving about 1 " around the outside and stitch in the ditch. Quilt decorative lines as you wish.
3. Trim to size as follows:
 - Front and back - $20\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - Top - $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - Side panels - $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

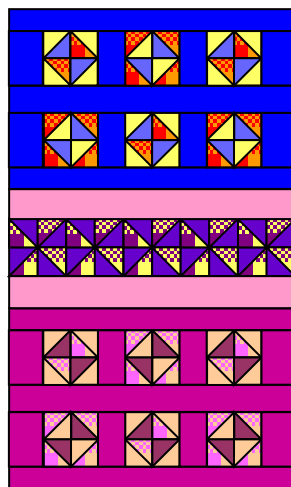

Assembling Outer Cover

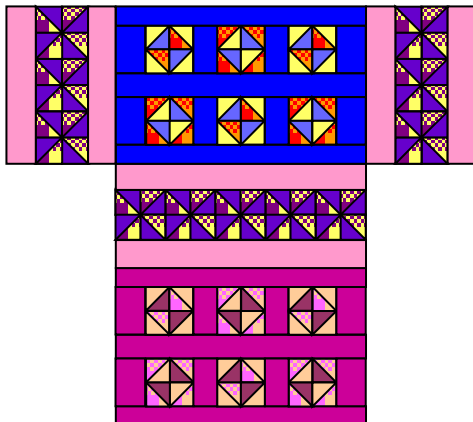

1. Sew the top to the front and back and press the seams open, **Figure 10**.
2. Sew in the side panels, stopping $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top, taking care to match the seams of the top to the top of the side panels so that it looks like a box, **Figure 11**.

Lining and Finishing

1. From chosen lining fabric cut:
 - Front and back - $20\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - Top - $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ "
 - Side panels - $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
2. Sew the top to the front and back. Press seams open.
3. Sew in the side panels, stopping $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top, taking care to match the seams of the top to the top of the side panels so that it looks like a box.
4. Place lining over the patchwork machine cover, right sides together and sew around the bottom leaving a small gap of 6".
5. Turn the cover and the lining through and press the bottom edge, hiding the gap.
6. Hem the gap by hand.
7. From the inside, secure the four corners with a few slip stitches.
8. Machine $\frac{1}{2}$ " along the outer edge of the bottom of the cover.
9. Admire!

Sewing Machine Cover

(Finished Size: 20" (w) x 12" (h) x 10" (w) approx.)

Showcasing fabrics from the Jett Sapphire range make this pretty patchwork cover to protect your sewing machine. Although designed to fit a Husqvarna Viking Sapphire, Diamond or Topaz it will also fit other brands.

Materials Required

- ½ m Jett Sapphire Sunstone
- ½ m Jett Sapphire Purple Diamond
- ½ m Pink e.g. Colourshott
- long ¼ m Jett Sapphire Agate
- long ¼ m Jett Sapphire Garnet
- long ¼ m Yellow e.g. Colourshott
- long ¼ m Orange/Red e.g. Summer Check
- long ¼ m Pale Gold e.g. Colourshott
- long ¼ m Pink/red e.g. Summer Check
- long ¼ m Dark Maroon e.g. Colourshott
- long ¼ m Yellow/Mauve e.g. Summer Check
- 1 m wadding (batting)
- 1 m lining
