



## Streak of Lightning

Using the Oakshott Charm Pack  
And Fast Half Square triangle units

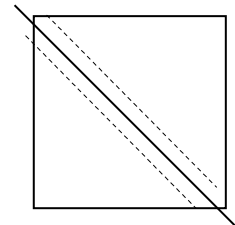
You will need a 5" square cut from your background fabric for each charm square you choose to use.

Place 2 squares (one from the charm pack and one background fabric) right sides together;  
draw a diagonal line across

Pin and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " either side of the line

Cut along the drawn diagonal line – this will give you two Half square triangle units.

Press and then trim each unit back to an accurate  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " – a bias square ruler is really useful as is the rotary turntable mat.



Once you have enough to play with you can lay them out in a pleasing design.

Any of the traditional log-cabin style designs works well

The Streak of Lightning example used 40 squares from the charm pack (and therefore 40 background squares – 1.10m of fabric)

Add borders, layer, quilt and bind.
